Gambling Act 2005

Sandwell Council is currently reviewing its Statement of Principles under the above Act. As part of this process it is necessary to consult with certain statutory bodies, local representatives and others likely to be affected.

The reviewed Policy will need to be approved by the full Council in January 2020 and will then be published and adopted in March 2020.

Local Authority policies generally are influenced mainly by Government Regulations and Guidance, which the Council has a statutory duty to have regard to when exercising its functions under the Act.

The Licensing Team are interested to hear any comments which assist the council in achieving its licensing objectives.
