New project launches

We are pleased to announce that our brand new Digi-Comm project - delivered in partnership with St Albans has started. Funding from our 12 month 'Know Your Neighbourhood' Lottery grant is being used to deliver Digi-Comm Unity within Sandwell.

SCIPS are leading on delivery of our well established 'digital for beginners' training package, but through this project we are taking learning for the first time into communal facilities within high rise buildings across the borough.

St Albans are leading on the recruitment, training and deployment of 'digital champion' volunteers to support digital inclusion activity both for this project and beyond.

We have commenced training initially at Hamstead House, enabling internet connectivity in the community room and offering a tablet loan to all participants. The support of Hamstead Village TRA has been key to delivery of this pilot. We will then review our offer and embed any learning before taking the Digi-Comm Unity project to an additional three venues across 2023/24.
