

## In October we will be holding our next TRA Networking Event

These are going from strength to strength, and following some really valuable feedback from groups at the last session, we are making a number of changes and putting in place improvements that will deliver even better outcomes for our TRAs;



1. We now have planning meetings with TRA representatives to codesign the format and agenda of these sessions, so that events really are 'for TRAs by TRAs'.



2. TRAs have suggested and are piloting hosting events in their local areas on a rotational basis across sandwell. Essex Avenue Community TRA have kindly volunteered to be the first to host the next event.

3. We have committed to having a standing item at each Networking session for all TRAs to update one another on the great work that they are doing as well as seeking feedback and suggestions from their peers.



We are hopeful that these changes, on top of the support and partnerships that have already been built through this forum, will ensure events remain relevant, enjoyable and beneficial to all of our TRAs across the borough.

# Tenant Engagement Strategy Task and Finish Group Update

To date the Task and Finish Group has met on 6 occasions.

We are keen to hear from as many people as possible, so when the consultation goes live, please take time to give us your feedback.


