This is your opportunity to network and share your experiences with other TRA's in Sandwell

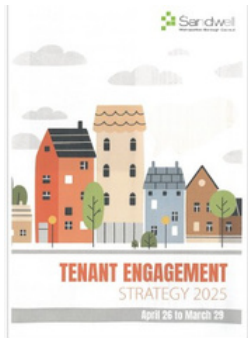

Tenant Engagement Strategy

The Tenant Engagement Strategy was developed and produced by a Task and Finish Group of tenants. They produced the final report that went out for wider consultation in October for 6 weeks.

A wide range of views were received and feedback was very positive on the layout, content and intention of the document.

However, a large percentage of those that responded said there was a perceived lack of communication and some scepticism about the Council's commitment to delivering the strategy's objectives.

The Strategy will go to the Safer Neighbourhood and Active Community Board on the 8th January and then to Cabinet in February and if approved it will be implemented in the new financial year. Tenants will be involved in monitoring the new strategy moving forward.



During November and December 2025 the HCBL Partnership gave out Tesco Vouchers by way of a prize draw to tenants and residents who have supported the programme over the previous 10 years as a way to help with the cost of living challenges.

Powered By Can on behalf of the project also gave out vouchers to the school champions who worked with them to deliver a range of activities.
